FYI- Tax returns are due on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>.

**Serving families with income less than \$54,000 and individuals with income less than \$35,000**

**IMPORTANT:** April 15-18<sup>th</sup>, tax sites will only prepare returns for tax year 2016 and tax year 2013

If you need returns for other years, you will need to make an appointment with us after April 18<sup>th</sup>

**WHAT TO BRING:**

- **Social security card, 1099 social security statement, or ITIN letter for every person to be listed on your tax return** (if you are applying for an ITIN, you do not need this document)
- Photo ID for yourself (and for spouse if filing jointly)
- Bank account and routing number for direct deposit of your refund
- All income documents for you, and for your dependents
- 1095-A if your purchases health insurance through the marketplace
- Copy of prior year tax return, if you have it
- 1098-T if you had college expenses.

**DO YOU HAVE THIS TAX SITUATION?** (If any of these apply to you, we will not be able to prepare your return.)

Our volunteers are only trained to prepare certain types of tax returns. If any of these apply to you, we will not be able to prepare your return. (This is not a complete list and there may be other instances when we cannot prepare a return.)

- You have an A, H, F, J, L, M or Q visa
- You were a cab driver. You drove for Uber or Lyft and had gross income over \$5,000
- You had complicated investment income (commonly reported on Schedule D)
- Income from Cancelled Debt (Form 1099-C or 1099-A); except in limited circumstances if the cancelled debt is credit card or mortgage debt.
- Rental income (including renting out rooms in your own home- no Air B&B)
- Self-Employment, business or cash income where your business is an LLC; has net loss, or loss carry over; has inventory, or sale of goods; paid employees, subcontractors; had business use of home; you take vehicle expenses instead of mileage; has depreciation expense; or you do not use cash method of accounting.
- Non-cash charitable (Goodwill, etc.) contributions greater than \$500
- Vehicle donation
- Unreimbursed employee business expenses (Form 2106)
